

Homework Project

Year 3 and 4 have got off to a great start in their History topic work around The Ancient Egyptians, Artwork on Egyptian Scrolls and their Science work around Electricity. To further support this learning, we are setting some homework activities to be completed by the above date.

Tasks for Homework – Children are required to choose and complete at least 5 of the tasks listed below. We ask that they choose at least one task from every column to cover a range of skills. They may choose to complete more than 5 tasks if they choose but 5 is the minimum expected amount.

Reading and Writing Fact finding/ research		Other (Craft, Maths, computer tasks etc.)
Research one of the Egyptian pharaohs. Create a factfile or biography about their lifetime (including marriage and children) and their famous achievements and legacy.	Research the system of writing using pictures and symbols used in ancient Egypt. Can you name and describe / explain the system? Can you write a message using the system?	Create a 3D model of an Egyptian pyramid, using any material you wish. You could even make the secret chambers and passageways inside too!
Create a timeline of major events during the Egyptian civilisation. Include how and when it began and how and when it ended, and the major events which happened between. Make sure you make it clear that the Egyptian civilisation was so long, it is split into different time periods.	Find out about everyday life in ancient Egypt. What would it have been like to live there? How would you dress? What would you have eaten? How would you source and cook your food? Create a diary which tells of “A Day in the Life” of an ancient Egyptian citizen.	Find out what ancient Egyptian people wore / how they dressed. an Egyptian wardrobe and jewellery in any way you like. You could draw and label different type of clothes jewellery items, or perhaps have a go at making some. You could even dress up, with essential eye make-up, and take photos!
Research the process of mummification. Then either write or draw instructions which explain how to do it and the steps in order. Have a go at mummifying something yourself, like a piece of fruit or vegetable.	Find out about Egyptian society. What were the different status that people could have. Show and explain how Egyptian society was constructed, who had power and influence... and who did not!	Create a picture or model of the famous Egyptian death mask / funeral mask. Use any materials you wish (paint, felt tips, glitter, paper mâché, etc). Remember that it has to look very sparkly, important and impressive!

As lots of books were lost during projects in previous years, we have made the decision to retain project books at school. Please complete tasks and bring them to school where they can then be stuck into books. Every Friday we will look at work brought in so far and celebrate it! If you require any paper to complete your work on, please speak to your teacher who can provide you with some. Also, if any work is not able to be stuck in, e.g. sculptures or 3D models, please take photos and send those in. Alternatively, email the year group address and we can print them in school.
