Year 6 have been enjoying their Topic work around World War Two. The children have learned or will be learning about:

To further support this learning, we are setting a Topic based homework project.

Tasks for Homework – Children are required to choose and complete **at least 6** of the tasks listed below. We ask that they choose at least one task from every column to cover a range of skills. They may choose to complete more than 6 tasks if they choose but **6** is the **minimum** expected amount.
