Tasks for Homework – Children are required to choose and complete at least 4 of the tasks listed below. We ask that they choose at least one task from every column to cover a range of skills. They may choose to complete more than 4 tasks if they choose but 4 is the minimum expected amount.

Record and write a weather report- choose one week to focus on Draw pictures of different types of weather and write sentences about what you like to do in each. Visit the local library, do they have books about the UK? Can you find out some key information about the countries in the UK? Make a list and draw pictures of different clothes you would have to wear for different types of weather.	Research the different countries in the UK- can you write facts and draw some key images for each one? Make a poster about how to keep safe in the sun. Research a hot country and a cold country- write about some key differences between these two countries. Find out and make a poster about why animals hibernate and what they do. To make a weather gauge using a plastic bottle and record the amount of rain that has fallen over a short period of time  Weather science- make a cloud jar and find out how clouds are made  Season walk- go on a walk and collect different things/take photos of things that you find to represent the season.
